- [1] In Table 1, the corresponding courses from other departments are provided for the courses in the Economics department curriculum. The compulsory courses in both programs are evaluated under Item [2].
- [2] Double Major Regulation Article 7.(3) The second major program includes all the courses from the related department's primary program. Equivalent courses taken in the primary program can be counted toward the second major program, and equivalent courses taken in the second major program can be counted toward the primary program. The equivalence of courses is determined by faculty councils, and the recognition of equivalent courses is executed through a decision by the board of directors. The grade for the recognized courses is displayed on the transcript with the same letter grade.
- [3] Double Major Regulation Article 9.(5) A student enrolled in the double major program must complete a total of three common education periods to graduate from both the primary and second major programs. Two of these common education periods are completed within the primary program, while one is completed within the second major program. However, students who complete the three common education requirements of the primary program while fulfilling the success criteria of the minor program, after which they are accepted into the double major program, are exempt from the common education practice of the second major program. (Additional sentence: Senate Decision No. 01/2, dated 13.01.2014)
- [4] Students enrolled in the International Entrepreneurship Department as primary students in the Economics double major program are only required to take one of the OEG 200-300-400 courses as an Economics student. These students are exempt from the other two common education courses.
- [5] When transferring horizontally from the International Entrepreneurship Department to the Economics department or pursuing a double major in Economics, the courses that can be recognized instead of IYD and OE-coded courses are provided in Table 3. Note: For all other related rules and regulations, see the TOBB ETÜ Double Major Regulation.
