Araştırma Profili

TOBB ETÜ İktisat Bölümü, Türkiye'deki iktisat bölümleri arasında en güçlü ve en çeşitli araştırma portföylerinden birine sahiptir. Bölümün öğretim üyeleri, önde gelen uluslararası dergilerde düzenli olarak yayınlar yapmakta ve teorik, uygulamalı ve politika odaklı araştırmalar yürütmektedir. Analitik ve ekonometrik derinliği gerçek dünya sorunlarına bağlayan bu çalışmalar, bölümün hem akademik mükemmeliyete hem de kanıta dayalı politika üretimine verdiği önemi yansıtmaktadır.

Bölüm öğretim üyeleri, bugüne kadar **83 farklı SSCI/SCI dergisinde toplam 139 makale** yayımlamışlardır. Bu yayınların **5 yıllık ortalama etki faktörü 2,953**'tür (Journal Citation Reports 2024). Öğretim üyelerinin akademik kariyerleri boyunca ürettikleri bu çalışmalar, diğer endeksli dergilerde yayımlanan makaleler, ulusal ve uluslararası yayınevlerince basılan kitap bölümleri ve Türkiye çapında yaygın olarak kullanılan ders kitapları ile tamamlanmaktadır.

Zengin araştırma birikimini kurumsal temel olarak benimseyen TOBB ETÜ İktisat Bölümü, iktisadi analitik akıl yürütme, nicel modelleme ve ampirik doğrulamaya dayalı bir uygulamalı bilim olarak yorumlamaktadır. Bölümde yürütülen çalışmalar, yöntemsel titizliği kurumsal, toplumsal ve etik duyarlılıkla bir araya getirerek hem uluslararası iktisat literatürüne katkı sunmayı hem de Türkiye'nin ve içinde bulunduğu bölgenin stratejik iktisadi sorunlarına ışık tutmayı amaçlamaktadır.

Bölümün Güçlü Yönlerine Genel Bakış

TOBB ETÜ İktisat Bölümünün, Türkiye'nin akademik iktisat dünyasına ve küresel iktisat politikası tartışmalarına etkin katkılar sunmasını sağlayan temel güçlü yönleri aşağıda özetlenmiştir.

Bölüm öğretim üyeleri, *The Economic Journal*, *Journal of Development Economics*, *Journal of Economic Theory*, *Journal of Human Resources*, *Games and Economic Behavior*, *Journal of International Money and Finance*, *Journal of Applied Econometrics* gibi saygın uluslararası dergilerin geniş bir yelpazesinde yayın yapmaktadır. Bu çeşitlilik, teoriyi, nicel yöntemleri ve politika odaklı ampirik analizleri bir araya getiren bir araştırma kültürüne işaret etmektedir.

Bölüm, Türkiye'de iktisat eğitimi alanında önemli bir konuma sahiptir. A. Talha Yalta'nın yazarı

olduğu *Modern Mikroekonomiye Giriş* ve *Modern Makroekonomiye Giriş* ders kitapları Türkiye genelinde birçok üniversitede yaygın biçimde kullanılmakta, böylece ulusal ders içeriklerinin ve öğretim uygulamalarının şekillenmesine katkı yapmaktadır. Fatih Özatay'ın parasal iktisat alanındaki temel başvuru eserlerinden *Parasal İktisat, Kuram ve Politika* kitabı ile İsmail Sağlam'ın Springer tarafından yayımlanan *Mastering Game Theory* (2025) kitabı da Bölümün yüksek nitelikli iktisat eğitimi alanındaki katkılarını güçlendirmektedir.

Bölüm öğretim üyeleri, Springer, Routledge, OECD, COMCEC ve diğer uluslararası kurumlar tarafından yayımlanan bilimsel kitap ve politika odaklı derlemelerde yazar, bölüm yazarı veya editör olarak görev alarak bölümün dergi yayınları dışındaki etkisini genişletmektedir.

Akademik yayıncılığın ötesinde, bölüm küresel ve ulusal politika ağlarına da etkin biçimde katkıda bulunmaktadır. Öğretim üyeleri, Dünya Bankası, Economic Research Forum ve Sustainable Development Policy Institute gibi kurum ve platformlar tarafından düzenli olarak davet edilerek çeşitli politika tartışmalarına katkı sunmaktadır. Ayrıca öğretim üyeleri, yurt dışındaki önde gelen üniversitelerde misafir öğretim üyesi veya sabatikal araştırmacı olarak sıklıkla çağrılmakta, bu durum bölümün uluslararası akademik tanınırlığını yansıtmaktadır.

Bu dinamik ortam, kıdemli, orta kariyer ve genç akademisyenlerden oluşan dengeli bir kadro yapısı ile desteklenmekte, işbirliği, mentörlük ve entelektüel sürekliliği teşvik etmektedir. Teori, makroiktisat, uygulamalı mikroiktisat, kalkınma ve kamu politikası ile ekonometri gibi alanlara dağılmış araştırma güçleri sayesinde Bölüm, hem uzmanlaşmayı hem de disiplinlerarası işbirliğini destekleyen dengeli bir akademik yapı sunmaktadır.

Tüm bu kurumsal özellikler, TOBB ETÜ İktisat Bölümünü, Türkiye iktisat toplumu içinde araştırma yönüyle etkin, dışa dönük ve politika süreçleriyle yakın çalışan bir bilgi merkezi olarak konumlandırmaktadır.
